**HONORS, PRIZES, AND AWARDS**

American Legion School Awards—A medal and certificate to be awarded to a boy and a girl in the graduating class on the basis of the following qualities: Honor, Courage, Scholarship, Leadership, Service, Companionship and Character.

The Charles and Ida Young Medal—A gold medal donated by the family of Charles and Ida Young is awarded to a member of the Senior Class, who has demonstrated outstanding originality and scholarship.

Robert E. Sault Memorial Band Award — Two plaques donated by the Lawrence High School Band Parents' Association given to a boy and girl member of the Band who excel in scholarship and musical talent, and who by faithfulness to the Band has contributed most to that organization.

Robert E. Sault Memorial Scholarships — Four one hundred dollar scholarships donated by the Lawrence High School Band Parents' Association to four deserving members of the Band on the basis of their scholarship and Band record.

Jane S. Gerrish Prizes—Two ten dollar prizes. One is awarded for the best work in Trigonometry, and the other for excellence in Plane Geometry.

Edward S. Riley Memorial Prizes—These books are awarded annually by the Lawrence High School Teachers' Association in memory of the late Edward S. Riley to a boy and a girl in the graduating class for excellence in character, scholarship, and wholesome influence on their fellow students.

Edward S. Riley Physics Medal—A gold medal donated by the Edward S. Riley family as a reward for excellent effort and scholarship in the study of Physics.

Edith A. Riley Chemistry Medal—A gold medal given by the family of the late Edith A. Riley to that member of the graduating class who ranks highest in the study of Chemistry.

## HONORS, PRIZES AND AWARDS

**Ernest C. Jewell Memorial Prize** — In memory of Ernest C. Jewell, who for more than a generation was a great teacher of youth through the instrumentality of Mathematics, the teachers of the Lawrence High School will offer annually a prize of ten dollars to that member of the graduating class who has shown the greatest aptitude for Mathematics.

**Edward F. Cregg Medal** — This medal is awarded to that boy in the Senior Class who because of his success as an athlete has won commendation for himself and has upheld the reputation of the Lawrence High School for honest, wholesome sportsmanship.

**Perkins Prizes** — Eight ten dollar prizes. These prizes are given each year to a boy and girl from each of the classes for excellence in original English composition.

**Gilbert E. Hood Medal** — A gold medal is awarded to that member of the graduating class who has won the esteem of teachers and fellow pupils, and who has done the most for himself, or herself, and the school.

**John C. Bowker Bulletin Prize** — The income from the John C. Bowker fund is awarded annually as a prize to that pupil who has shown the highest proficiency in spoken English during the four years in High School.

**Laurence J. O'Leary Memorial Medal** — A gold medal donated by the family of the late Laurence J. O'Leary as a reward for excellence in scholarship and cooperation in school activities.

**Bertha A. Merrill Memorial Award** — An annual award donated by her sister to be given to two girls in the graduating class who have done the most for the school as well as for themselves during their stay in the Lawrence High School.

**The Frances M. Brainerd Memorial Award** — A \$50 annual award donated by her sister to be given to the high school graduate showing the most improvement in Senior English.

**John W. Kennedy Memorial Scholarship** — A \$100 scholarship donated by the family of the late John W. Kennedy to be awarded to a graduate outstanding in History and Athletics.

**John F. Clark Memorial Scholarship** — A \$100 scholarship donated by the family of the late John F. Clark to be awarded annually to a graduate who has shown good character and has made the most improvement in Mathematics.

**Lawrence High School "L" Men's Club Scholarships** — Two scholarships given annually to two members of the graduating class who have been awarded the "L" for athletic ability and who merit it for the continuance of their education at some higher institution of learning.

**Italian-American Toilers Scholarship** — A \$250 annual scholarship from the Italian-American Toilers and their Auxiliary awarded to a deserving graduate who merits it for the continuance of education at some higher institution of learning.

**Lawrence Teachers Union — Local 1019** — This scholarship will be awarded to that graduate who, in the estimation of the scholarship committee, is deemed most worthy based on scholarship, contribution to the school, and need.

**Eagle-Tribune Scholarship** — Three scholarships of \$1,000 each are awarded annually by these newspapers to former newsboys for the continuation of their higher education; this year one is to be awarded to a former newsboy in the Lawrence High School graduating class.

**Thomas Downey Scholarship** — By the will of the late Thomas Downey, a fund of \$5,000 was established, the annual income of which is to be awarded in alternate years to the boy or girl in the graduating class of the Lawrence High School who in the Principal's judgement is best entitled to the money for the continuance of his or her education at some higher institution of learning.
